



Turkey Tissue Box

Supplies:

- Empty small tissue box
- Brown acrylic paint
- White cardstock paper
- Glue or glue stick
- Clear packing tape
- Scissors

Directions:

1. Start by painting the empty, small tissue box with brown acrylic paint.
2. While waiting for the paint on your tissue box to dry, print 1 copy of this page and 3-4 copies of the feather page (depending on how many feathers you would like) on white cardstock.
3. Cut out the turkey body and glue it to the front of the tissue box.
4. Cut out all the feathers, glue them to the back of the tissue box (with the colored side facing the front), and secure them with clear packaging tape.
5. Use your completed turkey as a Thanksgiving decoration or table centerpiece.





Turkey Tissue Box

Supplies:

- Empty small tissue box

- Paint, crayons, markers, glitter or other materials for decorating your turkey
- Glue or glue stick
- Clear packing tape
- Scissors

Directions:
